Synopsis:

In a sentence: Jesus reaches Simon in his darkest hour of need.

In spite of his arrangement with Quintus, Simon deliberately foils a Roman night patrol's attempt to catch Jewish fishermen fishing on the Sabbath; and he pays a painful price. Quintus suspects Simon of duplicity, so he sends the tax collector Matthew to spy on him. Simon comes clean with Eden about the desperate financial straights they are in. Andrew excitedly tells Simon he has met the Messiah but Simon is in no mood to listen. Simon spends a desperate and frustrating night fishing; catching nothing. At his darkest moment Simon encounters Jesus who teaches a parable from Simon and Andrew's boat, then sends the crowd away. Jesus then tells Simon to lower his nets into the water whereupon Simon is the recipient of an amazing miracle. Zebedee encourages his sons, James and John, to follow Jesus. Nicodemus visits the imprisoned John the Baptiser to ask him about miracles.

Questions for an informal discussion:

- 1. What did you think about this episode? Did anything particularly stand out for you?
- 2. What questions do you have about this episode?
- 3. Maybe it wasn't as dramatic as the miracle of the fish for Simon, but where have you experienced or witnessed a blessing from God?

For personal reflection and/or discussion with friends:

4. What things in our life can make it hard for God to get our attention?

5. Have you ever experienced Jesus coming to you after a "dark night" in your life? Would you share your story?

6. Just as Simon had to first cast his net into the water before Jesus performed the miracle of the

fish, where might Jesus be asking you to step out in faith?

7. Andrew met Jesus through John the Baptist and is eager to share the good news with Simon.

Who was an Andrew in your life and how did they tell you about Jesus? How did you react?

8. Reflect on where in your life Jesus might be pleading with you to spend a few moments with

Him.

9. Reflect on the parable Jesus teaches while standing in Simon's boat. What thoughts come to

mind?

10. Zebedee encouraged his sons to follow Jesus. Who might you encourage? How?

11. Over the course of the coming week: ask Jesus what he wants to show you or teach you in this

episode. If you are comfortable doing so, please consider sharing what comes to mind with the

group next week.
