The Chosen – Season 2 - Episode 7

Reckoning

Synopsis:

In a sentence: Jesus and the disciples prepare for a sermon that will define His ministry; Quintus and Jesus have a discussion and come to an understanding; the Pharisees continue to scheme against Jesus; Jesus teaches the disciples how to pray; Matthew is given a special assignment.

The episode begins with Atticus informing Quintus he has critical knowledge of "this Jesus of Nazareth". With the disciples out of food, Simon and Andrew are sent to fish, while Jesus continues to plan his sermon. The disciples discuss their doubts about Jesus' ministry and direct their anger at Mary for running away. Roman soldiers arrest Jesus brining him to Quintus for a discussion where Quintus tells Jesus "I was expecting someone crazier looking." Not seeing Jesus as a threat, Quintus releases Jesus to the relief of the disciples. On his return Jesus teaches the disciples how to pray and gives Matthew a special assignment in preparation for an upcoming sermon.

Questions for discussion:

- 1. What stood out for you in this episode? Were there any scenes or dialog that particularly spoke to you? Why?
- 2. Brandon Robbins suggests Jesus asked Matthew's help preparing the sermon because Matthew was one of the few disciples who could read and write, talents helpful to Jesus in developing the sermon.

Have you undertaken a Spiritual Gifts assessment exercise? If so, share the top one or two spiritual gifts that the exercise identified for you. In what ways do you think Jesus is using these spiritual gifts in your life?

3. At 38:30 Jesus says: "Prayer is the first step in getting the mind and the heart right. That's why you see me go to it so often."

Have you ever experienced *getting the mind and heart right* through prayer? Share your story if comfortable doing so.

- 4. If you had an opportunity to watch Brandon Robbin's *7 Things You Didn't Know About Matthew* (the third item in the Going Deeper section below) what stood out for you?
- 5. If you have had the opportunity to look at some of the other Going Deeper resources (below), was there anything that stood out for you?

6. **Over the course of the coming week:** ask Jesus what he wanted to show you or teach you in this episode. If you are comfortable doing so, please consider sharing what comes to mind with the group next week.
